



Turn Around Times (TAT)	<p>Routine Morning Labs: Heme/Chem available by 0715</p> <p>STAT: Results available <1 hr. (except TSH's)</p> <p>Urgent/Timed: Results available <4 hrs</p> <p>Routine: Results usually available <4 hrs (except batched tests, microbiology, and pathology/cytology)</p>
Release of Patient Results	<p><i>Inpatient results (Lab and Pathology)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Available in Electronic Health Record (EHR) immediately upon verification. <p><i>Outpatient results</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Available in EHR Available via fax (only upon request) Lab only calls critical results on outpatients. Patients can request a log in to their records via the portal.
Reference Laboratory	<p>Mayo Clinic Laboratories in Rochester, MN. We have daily courier service Monday-Saturday. Many of the tests are directly interfaced to our lab information system and are available on the BAH laboratory report and EHR. Reports that are not interfaced are scanned into t. Testing information can be found at https://www.mayocliniclabs.com</p>
Critical Values	<p>Notification of licensed care provider within 15 minutes of confirmed critical value. Person being called will be asked to "read back" pertinent information and provide their first/last name. Results can only be verbally reported to a physician or licensed care provider (i.e. RN, LPN, PA, NP). See attached critical value list.</p>
Blood Bank Products	<p>Leukoreduced RBCs, irradiated leukoreduced RBCs, single donor platelets (platelet pheresis), frozen plasma, and cryoprecipitate are available from the laboratory. All products are provided through the American Red Cross in Portland, Oregon. There may be delays of up to 36-48 hours in obtaining "special need" products (i.e. HLA matched, complex alloantibodies, autoantibodies, etc.).</p>
Pathologist Consult	<p>Pathologist is available to answer any questions or to perform frozen section evaluation 24/7. Please call the laboratory at 269-8071</p>
Autopsy	<p>Autopsies are limited to patients who have been admitted to BAH and are inpatients at time of death. A physician order is required. There is no charge. There is a 30 working day TAT for final results.</p>
Accreditation 	<p>The BAH laboratory is accredited through College of American Pathologists and CLIA.</p>
Communications 	<p>The BAH laboratory publishes an annual antibiogram. Updates are also sent out via the Scope.</p>
